

Tom is our middle child of 8 years, who had difficulties in starting to read and write in Grade 1. He started to give up on trying to learn reading and writing altogether and had lost confidence in his own abilities. It was heartbreaking to see his struggle.

At the beginning of Grade 2 Tom underwent an Occupational Therapy assessment with Yael at Dynamics. The assessment suggested an auditory processing disorder and visual tracking issues, and both were confirmed by the appropriate professionals later on.

Being able to sit through Tom's assessment with Yael, has equipped me as a mother with a much clearer understanding of where Tom's problems are. This allowed me to help him and understand better his reactions during daily routines at home. Yael's way of explaining each part of the test and the resulting consequences for Tom's understanding of his surrounding provided me with insight and suddenly all the pieces came together.

Yael was our 'SENT ANGEL' with her straightforwardness, caring attitude, fresh and active manner, and strong connection to Tom from the start.

Tom loves to go to his regular twice a week sessions with her and always jumps on his feet when asked to go despite having a friend over or being involved with his beloved Lego.

His improvements are impressive. Thanks to Yael's enormous knowledge about learning disabilities and her ability to focus on each child individually she managed to build up Tom's confidence in reading and writing. It never gets boring for him nor does she overburden Tom.

As we are leaving Singapore and returning to Germany, Tom has achieved much in a very short time. He was able and happy to learn another language to read and write and to go on doing the same in English, which only the thought of it half a year ago caused a huge distress for him.

Thank you very much Yael. You clearly love all the children who come to you and to tackle the huge challenges which differ from child to child together with the children. We could not have found a better partner to help all of us and especially Tom.

I wish many children and parents to find Yael ,who is the ideal teacher for any child but especially children with any special needs as I am deeply grateful to have found the way to her.
